ATTENDANCE

Attendance figures for week ending Friday 25th February are as follows:

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Year R 100%	Year 1 97.5%	Year 2 97.5%	Year 3 100%
Year 4 98.2%	Year 5 87.5%	Year 6 90.6%	96%

Whole school attendance this academic year: 93.8%

Above 95% is considered 'good' attendance.

The government is running a campaign to improve national attendance from January to March this year. It is called 'Moments Matter, Attendance Counts'.

Its aim is to try and improve avoidable absences where possible. Some information from the government campaign is printed below:

• In 2018/19, just 40% of persistently absent (PA) children (those whose attendance is below 90%) in KS2 achieved expected KS2 standards, compared with 84% of pupils who were regular attenders.

• 36% of PA children in KS4 got 9 to 4 in their English and maths GCSEs, compared with 84% of regular attenders.

• Regular school attendance can facilitate positive peer relationships, which is a protective factor for mental health and wellbeing.
